

PROTEIN FOODS

BEEF goes to front and center. Cool weather creates demand for roasts and other long-cook cuts . . . so many markets feature steaks. Watch for you family's favorite to appear. Something different for ground beef? Add chopped fresh cranberries to meat loaf or meat balls.

LAMB also abundant. Of course there are leg of lamb roasts and chops, but don't overlook the less tender cuts. How about cubes of lamb shoulder gently simmered to tenderness and nestled in garlic-spiked gravy . . . serve over fluffy mashed potatoes. Hungry?

PORK. Fresh pork is a bit scarce and prices are usually higher than for the other "red" meats. But watch for more "specials" on hams.

POULTRY. Chicken continue in abundant supply. Fryers are fine for an easy, quick meal. Just as easy . . . but not as quick . . . are the wonderful roasting chickens in our markets. Popular for rotisseries.

DAIRY PRODUCTS. Each month brings a round of festivities . . . October is put aside for cheese. Cheese production has been above last year's. Your markets will be stocked with large displays. The cheese of your choice . . . sharp 'n' tasty or deliciously mild . . . will be ready for you.

EGGS. Sliding up in price, but still continue as fine protein buy.

ON THE PRODUCE STANDS. Colorful array of fruits. Red and yellow apples; light and dark green avocados; a few strawberries; ruby cranberries; dusky figs; green, red, and

royal purple-black grapes; the yellows and orange of citrus fruits . . . plus the green of limes; melons of all varieties; a few late-late nectarines; peaches and Bartlett pears.




