Missionary To Outline Congo Crisis

Rev. Norman G. Riddle, American Baptist missionary from the Congo will speak at the Calvary Baptist Church, 2818 Manhattan Beach Blvd. Sunday at 8:30 and 11 a.m. duplicate services.

Rev. Riddle and his family were recently evacuated from the Vanga mission compound by a U.S. helicopter. About 125 other American Baptist missionaries and their families were similarly hurriedly removed from their fields of service when Congo army units defied authority and, among other irresponsible deeds, attacked some of our missionaries.

Church activities among native Christian leadership are reported to be continuing with remarkable stability in spite of the turbulent political unrest. It is also reported that an early return of the missionaries has been requested by Congo Christians.

Rev. Riddle's evangelistic work in Vanga included visits to the surrounding villages to meet candidates for baptism, examine regional schools and work with teachers and pastors. Mrs. Riddle has been active in training women in Christian home making.
