

# Winless Warriors Tackle Valley JC Here Saturday

## EC's Valmore Questionable For Metro Tilt

Having sampled the power of two of the nation's top ten junior college football juggernauts, the El Camino Warriors will continue their quest for Metropolitan Conference victory No. 1 Saturday night when they meet LA Valley College at 8 p.m. in Murdock Stadium.

The Monarchs, with 16 returning lettermen and several outstanding prep stars, will face a team that bounced from a horrifying 55-6 defeat at Bakersfield to a 12-8 setback at the hands of Long Beach last week.

With their line in top physical shape, the battling Warriors will be out to save face at the expense of the remaining five contenders in the rough Metro Conference.

**WARRIOR** backfield star Jim Valmore is again nursing the sore ankle which has plagued him throughout the still young season. Against Long Beach, "Val" was held to sparse yardage on the ground, but he caught five passes for 45 yards.

Valley was humbled by powerful San Diego, 55-0, last weekend. El Camino was a nine point favorite, despite its seemingly unimpressive 1-3 season record.

The Monarch's passing attack will be spearheaded by Phil Romoli, a letterman from last year, and Jim Zar, captain and end, for the hopeful LA crew.

Romoli will be the starting quarterback.

The Monarchs will employ a pro-style passing offense.

However the Monarchs will have a rough "sparring mate" in El Camino quarterback Ron Veres, who completed 19 of 36 for 190 yards in his last outing.

End Paul Burleson will be Veres' favorite receiver, having caught over 20 passes in the last three games.

IN EIGHT previous meetings with Valley, El Camino has taken five of the games. Last year the Warriors won 24-6, although Valley finished one notch above EC in the final standings.

## Torrance Favored by 10 Over Beverly Hills in Pioneer Tilt

Torrance's Tartars are laying in wait for their third prospective football victim in a row tomorrow night when Beverly Hills comes to town for a Pioneer League game in Tartar Stadium.

The locals, who stomped Lawndale 39-7 in the league opener last week, are favored by 10 points to conquer the Normans too. Kickoff is at 8 p.m.

However, despite last week's high score against the league's weak sister, Tartar Coach Irwin Kasten was dissatisfied with his club's showing—until the fourth quarter.

**TORRANCE** scored 19 points in the last period to compensate for a mistakes-filled first three quarters.

Halfbacks Jerry McLean and Mike Tracy carried the big offensive loads, averaging 11 and 10 yards a carry, respectively. McLean scooted for 111 yards in 11 carries, while Tracy ran the ball six times for 61 yards.

Beverly Hills, although winless in four tries, and 0-2 in the league, is setting its sights on an upset win. Former Torrance coach Bill Hoag, now at

Beverly Hills, says the Normans have been aiming for Torrance all season.

The Normans run out of about four offensive "T" formations. Last year Torrance scored a 13-0 victory in Beverly Hills.

**THE TARTARS** will go with their same offensive starting line-up, with McLean, Mike Irvine, Allan Billings and quarterback Howard Taylor in the backfield.

Taylor completed three of eight passes against Lawndale, one for a touchdown — to end Cliff Weimer.

Weimer and Rick Hood get the starting call at ends, while John Keith and John Carlson open at tackles, Rick Hansen and Mas Minemoto at guards, and Tom Holdsworth at center.

Torrance's offensive machine is starting to roll in high gear. Fumbles, however, keep throwing a monkey wrench into the operation.

**THE LOCALS** rolled up 17 first downs against Lawndale, but two costly fumbles early in the game changed the complexion entirely until the fourth quarter, when the team erupted for three TDs.
