Scout Trails

Boy Scout Troop 315,

The Navy Repair Ship USS Hector played host to Boy Scout Troop 315 and Explorer Post 315X last Saturday. Both groups are sponsored by the Torrance Moose Lodge 785. Arrangements for the trip were made by committeeman Dan Reyes with Herb Shattack coordinating the activity.

Captain R. Jack and his entire ship's company extended their finest courtesy to all the group. There were 22 scouts and seven adults from Troop 315, and 14 Explorers and three adults from Post 315X who took the trip.

Some of the highlights of the adventure were a morning snack of coffee or milk and donuts soon after leaving the harbor and scouts reading Morse code light signals from the admiral aboard an aircraft carrier; the message was "Boy Scouts of America Forever." There was an escorted tour of the ship's repair shops, the crew's quarters, engine room and boiler rooms.

Of special interest were the converters where sea water is converted to fresh water for use by personnel and also to supply the boilers for steam to power the two 6000 horsepower steam turbine engines. Off Catalina Island The Hector carried out a man-overboard drill with a helicopter aiding the rescue.

A buffet lunch of steak and all the trimmings were served the group at noon. The fine trip ended when The Hector anchored in the outer harbor and all hands came ashore in motor launches.
