Hull noted that the recent—and subsequent—tax override elections concern the operating budget of the district, or money for things necessary to operate a school.

"THE BUILDING program

budget is an entirely different matter," Hull said emphatically.

By 1970, with present trends and no change in the program, costs of education will have risen to about double what they are today.

funds is available for the work.

THIS PROJECT is one of a series of current or budgeted freeway jobs which will provide 30 miles of continuous freeway on the San Diego Freeway between the Long Beach area and north of the Ventura Freeway in the San Fernando Valley.

Eight traffic separation bridges are included in this project. These structures will be located at 174th St., Yukon Ave., 182nd St., Crenshaw Blvd., Arlington Ave., Western Ave., Normandie Ave., and Vermont Ave.-190th St.

THE SANTA MONICA Freeway job consists of construction of eight-lane freeway viaduct and grading and surfacing ramps and streets between Vermont Ave. and one-tenth mile east of Oak St. in Los Angeles.

A total of \$5,315,000 in state highway funds is available for the project. Bids will be opened Dec. 8 in Los Angeles. This viaduct section connects with previously completed and current work east of the Harbor Freeway.
