MINISTERS SCHEDULE JOINT THANKSGIVING

The traditional community Thanksgiving service will be held at the Calvary Assembly of God Church in Lomita at 7:45 p.m., Nov. 23, it was announced here yesterday.

The Rev. Leo B. Duncan, pastor of the host church, will deliver the Thanksgiving message, following the tradition of having the newest pastor in the Lomita-Harbor City area as the principal speaker.

Twelve churches associated with the Lomita-Harbor City Ministers Council, will sponsor the event again this year.

Pastor Wells Attends Convention Of Southern Baptists, Gets Post

Pastor Robert A. Wells of the Narbonne Avenue Southern Baptist Church attended the annual Southern Baptist General Convention in Stockton this past week. He was accom-

panied by his wife. Mr. Wells has served on the long-range planning committee that reported a complete plan of reorganization of the Convention at a special convention held in May. The Stockton Convention adopted the new constitution and by-laws recommended by the committee.

Church Slates Talk on Alcohol And Its Problem

The Rev. Alfred Harold, associate executive director of education and director of education for the Southern Area, California Council on Alcohol Problems, will be guest speaker on Sunday evening, 7:30 o'clock, at Harbor City-Lomita Methodist Church.

Sponsored by the Woman's Society of Christian Service, the guest speaker will present a 20-30 minute message on Alcohol and Christian Responsibility preceded by the showing of a film titled "Stop Driving Us Crazy."

The Council, an organization to promote united temperance ministry, is widely recognized by educational and civic leaders of youth for its program of Alcohol-Narcotic Education.

The Rev. Mr. Harold, an alumnus of the 1960 Yale School of Alcohol Studies, speaks before junior and senior high school students of Southern California as often as six times in a day.

The Rev. Clarence E. Spier Jr., church pastor, extends a cordial invitation to the public to attend the service. The church is located at 25904 Cayuga Ave., Lomita.

Mr. Wells also was elected to serve on the Convention's 32-member Executive Board. This is the convention's chief advisory board. Edwin T. Isbell, minister of music and education for the Lomita church, was elected to the Committee on Convention arrangements.

Pastor Wells will speak at both the 8:30 and 10:50 a.m. services on the subject, "Why I Am a Baptist."

"This is one in a series of messages on 'The Church in Today's World.' Too often people do not know what the church believes. This series of messages will seek to answer the many questions on the church of today," Mr. Wells stated.

The Sunday evening service will feature a film on mission work in Latin America. This will introduce the theme for the Foreign Mission emphasis during the Thanksgiving to Christmas season. This is a part of the church-wide effort to call to remembrance the real reason for Christmas.

The Lomita Church will host this Saturday night to the Girls Auxiliaries from the churches of the Long Beach-Harbor Area. A film on the life of Miss Lottie Moon will be previewed. The film is of such wide interest that the public has been invited.
