

Work on Area Animal Shelter Due Monday

Supervisor Burton W. Chace announced today that work on the Carson Animal Shelter will begin on Monday.

The County's new animal shelter, which is located at Broadway Ave., and Victoria St. in the Carson area, will include an office building, two kennel buildings and a barn and utility building.

Contract for building the new shelter was awarded by the Board of Supervisors last week to James E. Rowe of Lynwood for \$244,600. It will contain a total gross area of 11,944 square feet.
