Project HOPE Designed to Aid Millions With Medical Problems

Question—I have heard and read about the S.S. HOPE and Project HOPE. Can you explain just what this is? Is this a government project or what? Answer—Project HOPE is a non-governmental project designed to bring the benefit of American medical know-how to millions of short-lived and disease-ridden Asians. The S.S. HOPE, a converted Navy hospital vessel, is now in Jakarta, Indonesia, where native doctors, nurses, and technicians have come aboard with their patients to live and work alongside their American confreres—learning the latest in everything from burn therapy to the surgical correction of mitral stenosis.

HOPE'S PURPOSE is not so much to bring health directly to the millions of Asians as it is to improve the knowledge and skills of the native doctors and paramedical personnel. HOPE is financed through philanthropy and fund-raising much the same as other non-profit health organizations. In the American medical team staffing the SS HOPE are 15 doctors, 25 nurses, 20 medical technicians, two dentists, two dental technicians, four medical secretaries, and four administrative personnel. Also aboard are nine volunteer doctors in addition to the regular staff. The S.S. HOPE has 250 beds, operating rooms, clinics, and other facilities, and serves as a floating graduate medical school. In addition, out-patient clinics are set up ashore, off eight ports along the Indonesian shoreline, and in Saigon, Viet Nam. HOPE stands for "Health Opportunity for People Everywhere."
