Booster Night Plans Revealed By Moose Lodge

The fraternity's state officers will appear as guests of honor and principal speakers at a membership "Booster Night" banquet and dance to be presented by the Torrance lodge of the Loyal Order of Moose next Saturday, Jan. 28, at the lodge hall, 1744 W. Carson St., according to an announcement released today by Dan Hutchinson, governor of the Torrance lodge.

Preparations for the banquet and dance, scheduled to start at 6:30 p.m., are under the direction of George W. Clay, membership chairman, a past governor of the lodge, and a recipient of the fraternity's honorary Fellowship Degree.

Films of Mooseheart, the world-famous "Child City" of the fraternity, will be shown immediately following an address of welcome by Ray Hoffman, state membership committee chairman, and a brief introduction by Richard Vink, vice president of the California Moose Assn.

Prospective members and their wives, escorted by members of the lodge, will receive complimentary tickets to the program. Joe Rodulovich and his orchestra will provide music for dancing.

King Names 4 As Nominees to US Air Academy

Two young men from Torrance and two from Lomita were among the 11 named this week by Congressman Cecil R. King (D-Cal) to take competitive examinations for appointment to the 1961 class of the U. S. Air Force Academy.

Torrance men named included Jay Lawrence Lippman, 3813 W. 184th Place, and David Blair Kratzer, 25941 Richville Drive.

Lomita men included William Loyd Tenney, 25849 Appian Way, and Hugo Victor Heiner, 25428 Pennsylvania Ave.

Others named included two from Palos Verdes Estates, three from Los Angeles, and one each from Wilmington and Inglewood.

Congressman King said the nominees will compete for a place in the next class of the Air Force Academy that will number 770 young men from all of the 50 states who will be uniformly above average . . . morally, physically, and scholastically.

The College Entrance Examination Board tests, the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test, a physical aptitude examination, and the Academy medical examination will determine which young men are best qualified for appointment, he said.

Adoption of Second Sister City Studied

At a meeting this week, the group indicated it would favor a cultural exchange with a Latin American community in addition to the program now in existence between Torrance and Konya, Turkey.
