South High's sharp shooter, Joe Austin, increased his Bay League scoring lead Friday night by racking up 24 points against Hawthorne. Austin, with a 20 point average per game, is trailed by Inglewood's Garrick with 18 and Hawthorne's Mykkanen, also with 18.
