

Grandview Opening New 79-Home Community in West Palos Verdes

West Palos Verdes Estates, a 79-home community of custom-designed residences on ocean view terrain, now offers some homes for early occupancy, according to director of sales William C. Kulow.

Constructed by the noted Grandview Building Co., homes are designed with engineering and executive personnel in mind, and provide up to 2127 square feet of interior living space in eight plans which include a split level.

Furnished model homes are located near the intersection of Hawthorne Boulevard and Palos Verdes Drive West.

PLANS BY architects Harris & Rice, AIA, include varied arrangements of three and four bedrooms, family rooms, and two and 2 1/2 baths. One model, The Deauville, won the American Builder National Award of Merit for "use of quality design, materials and construction."

Ninety per cent financing is available, with VA terms on a select few. A trade-up plan in which Grandview utilizes its widespread resources to obtain a maximum price for the present home, has won popularity at West Palos Verdes. A free estimate is offered.

Adult School Offers 69 Courses In Semester Opening on Monday

Sixty-nine classes in 46 different subjects will be offered through Torrance Evening High School classes during the spring semester starting next Monday, Feb. 6, according to Principal R. E. Collins.

Courses will be offered for persons who want to get a high school diploma and those who have some special interest. Persons who plan to get high school credit should check as soon as possible with the Adult Education Office, 2200 W. Carson St., Torrance. Other registrations may be made at the first class meeting.

COMPLETE catalogs of offerings, times, and places are available through all Torrance schools by calling the Adult Education Office, FAirfax 8-8080, ext. 295.

Offerings range from U.S. history, algebra, and English to photography, investment securities, and woodshop.

A complete list of the offerings is as follows:

English, Speech, and Languages — English for foreign speaking, English review, spelling and vocabulary development, conversational Spanish, conversational French I and II.

Math and Science — Algebra, basic electronics, electronics — circuitry and schematics, general math, modern science, technical writing.

Social Sciences — Citizenship, U.S. government, U.S. history I & II.

Business — Bookkeeping and general records keeping, business English, business machines — electric typewriters — filing; investment securities, real estate law, beginning shorthand, advanced shorthand, stenographic, typing.

Homemaking — Decorating your home, dressmaking, food
