Acclaimed by critics as the greatest thing that ever happened to a piano, Little offers a wealth of musical fun in his initial engagement at Marineland Restaurant. He and his exuberant group moved into the "Porpoise Room" for a seven-week stand.

"Big" Tiny Little's quintet, "the happiest music this side of heaven," is a crowd-pleaser for all age groups, not just the people to whom ragtime recalls the nostalgic past.
