

Lomita Area Residents Seek Lights

Street lighting on Appian Way, between 263rd St. and Pacific Coast Hwy., may soon become a reality, according to Supervisor Burton W. Chace. A petition for this improvement is now being circulated in the Lomita area and those interested in the formation of the Lomita Lighting District should contact Max Grbelja, 25833½ Appian Way, Chace

said. Signatures of 20 or more property owners are needed before the improvement can be approved by the County Board of Supervisors. Plans call for installation of

11 street lights on wood poles, with the lights to be located between existing intersection lights on Appian Way, Chace said. Boundaries of the Lomita Lighting District are 240th St. on the north, 263rd St. on the south, City of Los Angeles on the east, and Atkinson Ave. on the west.

Veterans Advised to Keep Insurance Premiums Paid

Veterans Service Officer Sara R. Bridges said today she has some important advice for veterans holding GI insurance policies, regarding both premium payments and dividends. First of all, there have been some delays reported by the VA Insurance Center in the mailing of monthly premium notices, customarily sent out in packages of 12 for a year's supply. If policyholders have not received the packages by the time a premium is due, the service officer emphasized they should mail in their payments anyway so there will be no danger of a lapse.

PAYMENT checks should in such cases be accompanied by a note to the VA Insurance Center (usually in Denver, Colo.) giving the veteran's name, address, and policy number. If you pay premiums on more than one policy, be sure to list all policy numbers. This would prevent credit of the entire payment to one policy, leaving the other to lapse.

If you have no record of policy numbers, list your service serial number and birth date in the note.

REGARDING dividends, the service officer reported that under recent instructions from the President, VA is speeding payments of both National Service Life Insurance and U.S. Government Life Insurance dividends. The agency has announced every effort is being made to mail out as many dividends as possible before the end of winter.

It is anticipated that the speed-up process will enable the VA to pay all dividends by no later than June 30, and that the great majority will be out well in advance of that date.

ORDINARILY, the annual insurance dividends or refunds are paid during the year, as near as possible to the anniversary date of the veteran's policy.

Refunds are being made on both permanent plan and term insurance policies. It will be to the advantage of both the veterans and the VA, the service officer declared again, if policyholders do NOT make individual inquiries about their dividends.
