### Youth Band to Present Concert Sunday With Leonard B. Smith

Initial West Coast appearance of Leonard B. Smith, premier cornet-trumpet virtuoso, will be with the Torrance Area Youth Band next Sunday at 4 at the El Camino College Campus Theater.

The popular Herbert L. Clarke arrangement of the "Carnival of Venice" which was made famous during Clarke's 25-year tenure as solo cornetist with the Sousa Band, will be among the numbers to be featured by Smith Sunday evening.

Cellist Robert Rashid will be the student soloist for the concert, according to Director

James Van Dyck, who will lead the Youth Band. Young Rashid, a student at Nativity School here, is a member of the recently organized Junior Youth Symphony which is sponsored by the Torrance Area Youth Band.

The band will present the Nabucco overture by Verdi; An Occasional Suite by Handel; A Childhood Fantasy by Lilly; the "Cortege" from Mlada by Rimsky-Korsakov; the overture from El Seraglio by Mozart; and the Slavonic Rhapsody No. 2 by Friedemann.

Tickets for the concert are being sold by members of the Youth Band and the Junior Youth Band. Tickets also may be obtained at the door.
