Addressing members of the South Torrance Lions Club at its regular meeting at the International House of Pancakes last week was Joe Hennessy, district governor of District 4, Lions International, who spoke to the aims and goals of Lions in the Southland.

The statewide increase is 10.06 per cent, according to the commissioner. "Ordinarily, fatal accidents are lowest in the early months," he said. "If the increase is an indication of what the last 10 months will bring, California's 1961 traffic record will certainly be tragic."

Hennessy, whose district includes 81 clubs, is a past president of the Morningside Park Lions, and has served on many club and district committees during the past decade.

The film, which has been shown in television, was produced by a man who spent considerable time with the Navahos, and will visit the school during the showing of his film to answer questions and to comment on the scenes shown.
