

Industrial arts and shop teaching is an important part of a boy's education in a technological era, members of the Torrance Educational Advisory Committee were told at the group's monthly meeting Monday at the Torrance Masonic Lodge.

Presenting the topic, "Why Industrial Arts?", school officials discussed the program as it exists on a seventh and eighth grade level in elementary schools and in high school advanced courses.

Chairman Richard Welte, Carr principal, said that the program is designed to be broad enough to be valuable both to college-bound and vocational students. While every boy has the program in seventh and eighth grade, some 50 to 60 per cent of high school boys would be enrolled in high school courses during any one year, it was indicated.

EXPLORATORY courses in elementary school covers various phases, such as woodwork, metal work, drafting, plastics, electricity, and home mechanics, according to Myron Curtis, Newton shop teacher.

Purposes of the elementary

program, he said, were to give students practice in the use of common tools, in safety, in drafting, and in buying tools and building materials. It helps to identify students who have special talent in the field and to aid potential "do-it-yourselfers."

RICHARD Bullington, Torrance High instructor, told the group that high school work includes more advanced levels of work in drafting, woodwork, metal working, and metal work.

The courses in high school all are electives, with a four-year program available for

students who plan to do work
