Urban Renewal Conference Set At Harbor Area

Urban redevelopment problems will get the once over at a conference called by the Harbor Area Welfare Planning Council for April 8 at Harbor College. The day-long meeting will feature talks on various problems of Harbor Area cities.

"The purpose of the conference is to learn how blighted conditions in our community which affect the health and safety of its residents and deter its economic development, can be remedied through urban renewal and similar programs," Chairman Ray Choate said in announcing the meeting.

Problems which will receive special attention will be run-down neighborhoods, inadequate streets, lack of retail business, lack of housing for low income groups, and lack of community facilities such as parks, churches, schools, and others.

The conference, which will be run from 9:30 a.m. until 2 p.m. will be open to the public.
