First Good Teaching Conference To Be Conducted Here Saturday

Torrance teachers will see some 60 demonstrations of good instructional techniques Saturday at the first Good Teaching Conference, according to Willard G. Andreasen, president of the sponsoring Torrance Education Assn. Theme of the conference, sponsored by the teacher group and the Torrance Unified School District, is the "Growing Edge." Demonstrations of top-flight techniques are slated in reading, writing, arithmetic, science, art, music,

English, and various other subjects taught in the schools. The meetings are planned to acquaint teachers with new and proven methods of teaching various subjects. Dr. Irving Meibo, dean of the University of Southern California School of Education, will deliver the opening address at a 9 a.m. meeting at South High school. Afterward, teachers will break up into smaller groups to see the demonstrations, which will be at South High and Calle Mayor Elementary School. Each teacher can see two demonstrations.


