

# Public Schools Week Programs Listed for Torrance Schools

The Torrance Schools' observance of Public Schools Week (April 24-28) will include special events at most schools, including dedication ceremonies at two new plants and a program at the Torrance Masonic Lodge, according to Assistant Superintendent Albert N. Posner.




