**Slate Picked For Moose Lodge Vote**

Douglas Dixon, Dan Hutchinson, and Joe Marley have been selected as nominees for the office of Governor of the Torrance Moose lodge, according to a report of the lodge's nominating committee released this week by James A. Evans, lodge secretary.

The committee announced the names of the candidates for the lodge's highest office after deliberations covering three weeks. The annual election will be held at the lodge hall, 1744 W. Carson St., on Tuesday, April 5.

Dixon is completing a term as prelate of the Torrance Moose lodge, and Joe Marley is the present junior governor of the fraternal organization. Dan Hutchinson has served the lodge in many capacities during his membership, and is now the chairman of the conservation committee.
