Father Percy has previously discussed "Nuclear Energy and the Church," "Racial Problems and the Church" and "Christian Conscience and our Foreign Affairs Policy."

Remaining topics include "The Church and Community Services," scheduled for April 3; and "The Church and Man's Freedom," scheduled for April 10.

Members of the church vestry and the acolytes will attend corporate communion at 7:30 a.m. Sunday.

Frederick A. Schnell, over-all chairman of Los Angeles County, said the campaign now stands at 39 per cent of its goal of \$3,316,468.
