Three-Quarter Million Dollar Jump 'n Jack Expansion Started

Expansion of Jack Rogers' Jump 'n Jack establishment at 2900 Pacific Coast Hwy. has begun with a program which will add two motel units and a coffee shop at a cost of \$750,000. Two additional motel buildings are to be added later with an additional expenditure of \$500,000.

According to Armet & Davis, AIA, architects for the project, the T-shaped coffee shop to be built will seat 50 guests. The building, in addition to the cafe, will also contain a barber shop and a beauty parlor, motel lobby, and a TV lounge. The 4632-square-foot building will make extensive use of stone; diagonal, rough finish wood; and terrazzo. The roof will be in three lighted tiers and will have a rock surfacing.

THE MOTEL buildings will be two stories in height and will contain 44 units apiece. There will be single-room apartments with connecting doors to provide larger accommodations for families. Each room will have a dressing area. A walk-through will be provided in the rear motel building to give its tenants access to the pool. Lower-floor apartments will have patios.

SOUNDPROOF sheet rock walls will be used in the units. Ceilings will be sprayed with acoustical plaster. All floors will be carpeted except in the
