Torrance-Made Rigs in Largest Well Drilling Shipmet to India

The largest single shipment of oil well drilling equipment from the United States to India was announced here today.

The shipment reported by the Export Division of The National Supply Co., includes two trailer-mounted drilling rigs, complete with 97-foot masts and power equipment, drill pipe, and 66,800 feet of steel casing.

National Supply manufactured most of the machinery and equipment in its plant at Torrance and at Gainesville, Texas,

and produced the pipe in its seamless tubular mill at Ambridge, Pa. The rigs, which also included components from other manufacturers, were rigged-up and test assembled at National Supply's Houston, Texas, plant before being loaded on shipboard at Houston.

THE RIGS are National T-45's, normally considered for drilling in the 4500 to 7500-foot depth range. National equipment for each rig includes the T-45 draw works,

Type SA-175 rotary machine, Type N-35 Swivel, Type 430-E-140 Hook-block, Type C-250 Slush Pump, Type C-150-B Slush Pump, and an independent pump drive for use with the C-150-B Pump.

PRODUCTS OF other manufacturers for each rig include three General Motors 12107 Diesel Engines (two for powering the rigs and one for the independent slush pump), a Lee C. Moore Mast, and single trailer assembly mounted on

Athey tracks to be drawn by a Caterpillar tractor.

The casing shipment includes 52,800 feet of 5½-inch, 12,800 feet of 9 5/8-inch, and 1200 feet of 13 3/8-inch, all Spang API Casing. Other tubular products shipped were 16 drill collars—each 4¾-inch diameter by 30 feet, and 14,000 feet of 3½ Spang Double Seal Shrink Thread Drill Pipe with Tool Joints.

M. S. RAM, director of the India Supply Mission, inspected the equipment at the rig-up
