Garden Checklist

By California Association of Nurserymen

- 1—Look hard for any new signs of aphid and other pests in rose beds. Spray for them only during windless intervals of this often windy month, however.
- 2—A good mulch of steer manure is one sure way of giving hydrangeas the rich, cool, moist soil they so thrive on.
- 3—Seedling tuberous begonias are available in nursery flats now. Plant them in light, not deep, shade for best results.
- 4—Try training tomatoes on a sunny fence or garage wall. You'll be surprised at the crop you get from a few plants.
- 5—Pinch out the growing tips of fuchsias to encourage bushy growth. The fuchsias can be trained by pinching to almost any growth pattern you desire.

Master Plan Needed to Remodel

Bar Mitzvah Slated for Torrance Lad

Seth Alpert, thirteen-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Myer Alpert of 1333 Cordary Ave., will be called to the pulpit of Temple Menorah of the South Bay, 112 N. Catalina Ave., Redondo Beach, Saturday morning at 11:30 to perform the traditional rite of Bar Mitzvah (Confirmation). This ancient ritual of the Jewish religion signifies the understanding of the Hebrew language and of the religious ceremonies and customs which every Jewish boy is required to know by that age.

During the services, which will be conducted by the Bar Mitzvah, Alpert will read from the Torah (the Holy Scripture), and from the message of this Biblical passage will deliver a sermon to the congregation.

THE AGE-OLD blessing "May the Lord bless thee and keep thee" will be pronounced upon the lad when he has finished with these rituals. This benediction from the Book of Numbers will be invoked by Rabbi Henri E. Front, spiritual leader of the congregation. The regular sermon will also be delivered by Rabbi Front.

Following the services a special reception in honor of their son will be presented by the Alperts. The services, as are all Jewish religious observances, are open to the public.

ON THE previous night, at 8:30 p.m. at the Temple, the mother of the Bar Mitzvah, Mollie Alpert, will open the Sabbath Services by lighting the Sabbath candles and asking the benediction over them. Mrs. Alpert a member of the Temple Menorah Choir, will sing the blessing.

Accompanying her will be Fay Newman, organist and choir director. Harry Newman, cantor of the temple, will chant the remaining parts of the Sabbath liturgy.
