If an All-American girl were picked to represent the United States in Europe the selection could very well be Linea Hileman, a junior at North High School in Torrance.

Miss Hileman, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jack C. Hileman, of 17026 Yukon, is an attractive girl of 17 who combines her physical assets with poise, a youthful freshness found in the cross-section of American teenage girls, and a studious mind reflecting an eagerness for learning.

Linea could symbolize the youth of America, and now her dream has come true—she is going to Europe for further study in languages, her major subject in school.

Linea has dreamed a dream since she was in the eighth grade and started corresponding with a "pen pal" in both Switzerland and England. Now this dream has come true and she will study in Europe under the American Field Service program.

## Local Bank Official to Attend UCLA

R. H. Sherrett, assistant manager at Bank of America's Torrance branch has been selected to attend the second annual two week resident seminar on industrial management beginning Sunday at the University of California at Los Angeles.

The seminar is sponsored by the bank in cooperation with the UCLA Graduate School of Business Administration and University Extension. The faculty of the university's graduate school prepares the courses studied by the bankers and presents the lectures.

Sherrett will be one of 30 Bank of America branch administrative executives from California's manufacturing areas who will take this opportunity for a close study of industrial plant organization and management.

Four plant field trip inspection tours will be taken by the students during the course. Included in their visitations will be Packard Bell, Brunswick Drug Co., McCulloch Corp. and Ducommun Metals. Purpose of the field trips is to present on-the-spot examples of management operations studied in the classrooms.

Classroom and lecture studies cover management organization, production and accounting, marketing, industrial, and human relations.

Linea told the panel before she was selected that being a language major, study in countries she is interested in would help her. She planned to go into the teaching profession when her education is finished. She added that she felt she could be a good example of an American student.

The North High junior has not been assigned to any specific country, but hopes she will be sent to Germany, or a country speaking German, so she can further her language studies by living with these people and conversing with them.

This typical All-American Torrance girl also hopes she may have an opportunity to visit pen pals in Switzerland and England.
