High Mormon Official to Speak Here

A prominent leader of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (Mormon) will address a two-day conference of the Church's Torrance Stake Saturday and Sunday, April 30 and May 1, in San Pedro.

The visiting official is Elder Howard W. Hunter, a member of the Council of the Twelve Apostles, who represents the Church headquarters in Salt Lake City.

SATURDAY evening meetings will be for leaders of the local congregations. Sunday's general sessions, open to the public, will be held at 9:30 a.m. and 2 p.m.

Stake President Roland Earl Gagon, 3332 Winlock Road, will conduct the meetings.

ELDER HUNTER was a prominent Southern California lawyer and businessman before his call to the Apostleship on October 10, 1959. Originally from Boise, Idaho, he served the Church as a bishop, Stake high councilman, and as president of the Pasadena Stake.

All conferences held in 1960 will focus emphasis on youth development as part of a special Church-wide parents and youth program launched early this year by Church President David O. McKay. A parents' session on youth problems is Saturday night at 8 p.m.

Conferences are held four times each year in the nearly 300 stakes (regional divisions) of the Church. Church leaders regularly tour the 50 missions throughout the world where more than 6000 young missionaries are engaged in proselyting activities, each paying his own expenses for a period of two or three years.
