


Details of YMCA Summer Camping Schedules



SUMMER HIGHLIGHT . . . The "ole swimmin' hole" has been replaced by modern, clean, guarded pools in the YMCA's summer camping program. Through the camping programs, Torrance youth join others of the West in supervised water safety demonstrations and a splashing good time.

Rev. Gilbert Zimmerman, chairman of the Torrance YMCA Camp Committee, announced the Summer YMCA camp dates this week. Twelve different sessions are offered to serve boys and girls from six years old through adult groups.

Zimmerman stated that the local youth agency is specializing in teen-age caravans, pack trips and boat expeditions in order to provide an adventurous outdoor program for older youth. Along with these, the YMA continues to provide traditional resident camps for both boys and girls at nearby mountain locations.

THE YMCA has designed its first week-long family camp this year, using a special site in Yosemite National Park. Families are urged to camp together in this beautiful valley from June 16 to 23.

The first camp of the summer is a Father and Son Camp to be held at Chilao for boys six to nine, along with their dads, on June 4 and 5.

ONE DAY AFTER the school

vacation begins, the YMCA's Tri-Canyon Caravan departs for a nine-day camping tour of Lake Mead, Zion, Bryce, Cedar Breaks, and Grand Canyon National Parks. Boys 12 to 15 will see both rims of the Grand Canyon, and will spend one night visiting the Navajo Indians who have been adopted by the local organization.

During the same week, 25 boys from 11 to 14 will set up a Base Camp along the shores of Florence Lake in the High Sierras. During their week, the group will explore Dinky Creek, Huntington and Shaver Lakes, and will spend many hours hiking, fishing and learning camp-out skills.

FROM JUNE 22 to July 3, the Torrance YMCA will operate a Grand Teton Tour for boys 14 to 21. Mountain climbing with experts, horseback riding, sighting moose and caribou, and swimming in Jackson Lake will occupy major blocks of time on this colorful trip to the Rockies.

Another group of boys 14 and older will take the first

leg of the famed John Muir Trail from Yosemite Valley, over Vogelsang Pass to Tuolumne Meadows. They will backpack some 40 miles through lovely high country meadows, crags and lakes. This hike is considered an introductory experience to enable boys to learn this satisfying lifetime sport.

TEEN-AGE girls are invited on the YMCA's Monterey Peninsula Caravan from July 18 to 23. The girls will travel up the coast to see Santa Barbara, Morro Bay, San Simeon Castle, Big Sur Redwoods, Carmel, historic Monterey and Pinnacles National Monument. Camping along the way, the girls will be directed by Mr. and Mrs. Frank Renk of the YMCA staff.

Camp Round Meadow will play host to 145 Torrance boys from 9 to 12 years of age during Aug. 8 to 13. Sporting a new heated swimming pool and all new cabins, Round Meadow will stress swimming lessons, nature lore, handicraft, and plenty of boy-fun lore.

DURING THE same week, girls 9 to 12 will attend YMCA Camp Mozumdar near Crestline to enjoy hiking, horses, ice skating, crafts, swimming, archery and nature study.

Rugged boys, 14 and older, will join the Torrance "Y" on a Sacramento Riverboat Expedition from Aug. 16 to 21. They will travel upstream some 200 miles from Sacramento to Redding, camping along the shore each night. Fish, waterskiing, skin diving, swimming, helmsmanship, and sight-seeing the wild country will keep them busy. John March, the expert boatsman who directed the Y's first riverboat trip up the Colorado during Christmas holidays, has agreed to lead this adventurous group.

FROM SEPT. 2 to 11, still another group of boys 14 and older will "go on their own steam" some 90 miles along the John Muir Trail. They will backpack from Lake Mary on the Eastern side of the High Sierras across nine high passes to reach Huntington Lake on the Western slope of the

great mountain range. Using survival tactics, dehydrated food and fishing skills, the group expects to gain weight on their long trek. Alpine Expert David Graham will join YMCA Secretary Joe Wilcox in conducting this rare trip.

High school and college boys and girls are invited to spend Sept. 6 to 13 at YMCA Camp Whittle for a Leadership Development Camp. This camp provides youth with an opportunity to set life goals; improve skills in getting along with others; and, receive inspiration through discussion and meditation each day. Counseling and problem solving are a specialty at this camp, along with fun and relaxation.

THE SUMMER will close with a week-end Family Camp at YMCA Camp Big Pines Sept. 17 and 18. Kids are entertained by the "Y" staff while parents enjoy log-sitting and lounging at the camp pool.
