## Fishing Flashes

**Striped Bass Reward Tags Being Placed**  
 Striped bass fishermen will once again get a crack at bonus \$5 bills when they fish for strippers this year.  
 The Department of Fish and Game has announced it will again affix \$5 reward tags to some 250 strippers in the San Francisco Bay and Delta areas to stimulate returns of tags to the Department.  
 Purpose of the tagging program is to gather information on striped bass habits and migrations. This data will aid in the continuing effort to protect this fishery from pollution and other threats.

**San Diego**  
 Featuring the heavy run of large yellows which still is gaining momentum at the Coronado Islands, busiest week of the 1960 San Diego sportfishing season was crammed with such other items as the crowning of a new leader in the \$25,000 Yellowtail Derby, rise in its qualifying weight, and a \$2152 payoff in the Boosters' Bonanza.  
 Yellowtail catches at the Islands for the last five days, all from 16 pounds to 29.4. As a result, the minimum qualifying weight in the derby stood at 18.7 as the seventh week of qualifying began last Sunday.  
 Qualifiers from Torrance this week included: 18-15, John Worobieff, 403 W. 22nd, Torrance; 19-15, Dick Walker, 257th St., Lomita.

**Barracuda Running Strong in Redondo**  
 Barracuda continued to run strong for saltwater anglers off Redondo Beach during the week, with skippers of three Redondo Beach based sportfishers anticipating big week-end crowds.  
 Best fishing was in waters off Playa del Rey and El Segundo, about four to six miles north of Redondo. Jigs and anchovy were doing the trick.

 Fred B. Reeves of 22353 Alexandria St., Torrance, was a jackpot winner recently on board the sportfisher "G.W." Redondo Beach Landing, when he caught a 5-pound sea bass.  
 Orvin D. Barnard of 1625 W. 220th St., Torrance, was a jackpot winner on board the sportfisher "City of Redondo," when he caught a 5-pound sculpin.

## New Policy, Flow Line Head Entries for Race at Hollypark

New Policy and Flow Line, two of the nation's top stars of the winter racing season, head a list of 20 fleet three-year-olds which have been nominated to the \$25,000 added Debonair Stakes, highlight of Hollywood Park's first Saturday program on May 14.

The thoroughbred racing season opened at the Inglewood track yesterday.

**RACING SECRETARY** John Maluvius today released the

roster of nominees for the six-furlong event for sophomore colts and geldings, many of whom will be starting a campaign aimed at the \$100,000 added Hollywood Derby on July 9.

New Policy, runner-up in three stakes at Hollypark as a two-year-old and winner of three added money events last season at Santa Anita, was nominated for Owner Ralph Lowe. Flow Line, winner of the San Felipe Handicap and unsuccessful favorite in the Santa

Anita Derby, was named for Owner C. M. Crawford, Jr.

SEVERAL other very hard-hitting three-year-olds were also nominated, including Giant Guy, third in the California Derby; Clown Prince, a recent sprint winner in 1:09 1/5; Windy Sea, a late developing \$18,000 yearling purchase with great promise, and King Moisha, a highly-regarded stakes winning French-bred formerly owned by Queen Elizabeth.

## All-Night Barge Fishing Begins

All-night barge fishing will begin Friday on two barges located two miles off Redondo Beach, Redondo Pleasure Fishing chief Gordon McRae reports.

And "all night" means just that. Starting at 6 p.m. both Friday and Saturday night the launch will make an hourly run from the wharf to barges and back until 1 p.m. From 1 p.m. launches will cease activity until 6 a.m. McRae said the "all-night" schedule will be continued to Friday and Saturday nights through the better part of the month, and then

will go daily except Sunday. BARGES ARE equipped with well-stocked bait tanks and restaurants. Restrooms and and ship-to-shore, or barge-to-beach, communications are available.

A third barge, the converted ferry "Sacramento," will join the other two barges in a few weeks, McRae said. It is currently undergoing last minute refurbishing in a Long Beach boatyard.
