

Air Force Gets Heavy Increase In July Quota

The Air Force recruiting service has announced that July enlistment requirements have been heavily increased over previous requirements.

According to T/Sgt. Duane K. Hetler, local Air Force recruiting representative, the increase will provide an opportunity for enlistees to receive immediate training assignments rather than being placed on a waiting list.

Students graduating from high school who do not plan to enter college may find the increase to be of particular interest since the valuable technical training available in the Air Force could very well fit into future plans. While the Air Force encourages students to continue their education, well qualified high school graduates, particularly those with technical ability, are always in demand to train for and work in important jobs.

Sgt. Hetler explained that, in addition to the immediate training advantage, the increased quota provides the opportunity for "Buddies" to enlist and receive their basic training together. In many such cases, friends who have enlisted together have continued on to the same technical school and received duty assignments together.
