

## Family Life Institute Planned At Ascension Church on Sunday

The Southern California District of the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod will sponsor a Family Life Institute on April 30 at 2:30 p.m. at the Ascension Lutheran Church, 17910 South Prairie, Torrance, announces the Rev. Lloyd C. Warneke, pastor of the church. Registrations begin at 2 p.m. Similar institutes will be conducted throughout the southland and Arizona on that date.

The program will provide interest group workshops to cover every phase of family life from kindergarten through retirement age. To complete the day's event, a spaghetti dinner will be served at 5:30 p.m.

THE Rev. Kurt Klein, pastor of First Lutheran Church, Manhattan Beach, will give the keynote address, "Shatterproof Families." The Rev. Lloyd C. Warneke, pastor of the host church, will conduct the opening devotions, with the Children's Choir participating. Rev. Arthur Zschiegner, pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church, El Segundo, will present the closing devotions.

Dorothy Dashnaw, Manhattan Beach, will lead the workshop for the elementary group, ages 6-11. Mrs. Dashnaw will present Bible stories of Christian families in flannelgraph, song, and story.

TEENAGERS' workshop will be conducted by Richard Knipp, El Segundo, of the Juvenile Delinquency Dept. of the L. A. Police Dept. In his discussion, Knipp will emphasize the importance of forming Christian standards and teaching teenagers how to "put up" with Mom and Dad during these "difficult years."

In the pre-marriage group, the Rev. Harold Kupke, 18033 South Glenburni, Torrance,

will serve as the main speaker. Rev. Kupke, instructor at Walter A. Maier Lutheran High School, is teaching a course in "Education in Marriage" at the University of Southern California. In his discussion he will stress the seven marks of a Christian home.

GUY BESNARD, Westchester, psychologist for System Development Corp., will conduct the workshop for parents of young children. Besnard will emphasize Christian child training in developing right attitudes, Christian teaching and problems parents encounter in rearing their children.

For the "Parents of Teenagers" workshop, John Rosenthal, Redondo Beach, will give assistance to members of the family in understanding one another. He will discuss teenage problems and how best to assist the teenager "cross the bridge" from childhood to adulthood.
