Pedestrians as well as all drivers of motor vehicles should make themselves aware of their rights and duties, according to Lt. Don Nash, head of the Torrance Police traffic division.

In speaking on the rights and duties of pedestrians, Nash said pedestrians crossing the roadway at an intersection controlled by traffic signals should take time to observe the red "Wait" or green "Walk" signal.

nals when present, and obey them.

"At all times, be certain to cross the roadway only when it is safe to do so," he cautioned.

THE OFFICIAL rules governing the actions of pedestrians at intersections controlled by the Walk-Wait-Don't Walk signals are laid down clearly in the California Vehicle Code, the uniform traffic regulation governing the state's streets and highways.

Whenever an official traffic control signal exhibiting the words "Walk" or "Wait" or "Don't Walk" are in place, the signals shall indicate as follows:

WALK. A pedestrian facing the signal may proceed across the roadway in the direction of the signal or in a diagonal direction across the roadway within the intersection if so instructed by signs or signals installed at the intersection.

pedestrian shall start to cross the roadway in the direction of such signal, but any pedestrian who has partially completed his crossing on the "Walk" signal shall proceed to a sidewalk, safety zone, or island while the "Wait" or "Don't Walk" signal is showing.

This means, Lt. Nash pointed out, that at intersections at which the pedestrian signals are in operation as well as the common green, yellow, and red signals for motor vehicles, the pedestrian must be guided by the "Walk" "Don't Walk" signals.

ALTHOUGH the signal may be green, pedestrians must wait on the curb if the sign facing them says "Don't Walk."

Trophies will be awarded to first place winners in each category with certificates being awarded to second and third place winners.


