

# Construction on New Temple on Schedule Here

Construction of new facilities for Temple Menorah of the South Bay is moving along rapidly, according to George Lewison, Temple president. Shown above are Mr. Lewison and Rabbi Henri E. Front looking over plans in front of the new temple at its present stage of completion.

The congregation which was organized over 14 years ago by Mr. and Mrs. I. H. Grancell and a handful of Jews has outgrown the present location at 112 N. Catalina Ave., Redondo Beach. The new temple is located on a three-acre site in a commanding location where the Redondo Beach-Torrance city lines meet near El Camino Real and Knob Hill. It will serve persons of the Jewish faith in the entire South Bay and Palos Verdes Peninsula areas. Architect Kenneth N. Lind, AIA, won an award for the design of this building as an outstanding example of a modern religious structure.

COMPLETION of the present phase of the building program is expected sometime between August and September. It will include a large social hall which will be used temporarily as a sanctuary and will be capable of seating over 600 people. Also being built at this time are ten classrooms for the religious school, administrative offices, library, rabbi's study, recreation room and kitchen.

Rabbi Henri E. Front, spiritual leader of the congregation, is the current President of the South Bay Ministerial Assn. With his guidance Temple Menorah has become one of the best known Jewish congregations in the Southern California area. The religious school under the supervision of Rabbi Front and its principal, Norman H. Horowitz, has achieved an outstanding record of attendance and scholastic achievement.

## Country Club Unit on Peninsula Attracting Area's Home Buyers

Attracting a great deal of attention is the new Country Club unit at Grandview Palos Verdes is the Deauville, one of 14 plans being offered in the 136-home section. Winner of a 1960 national award-of-merit, the Deauville contains four bedroom, a large family room, three baths, with 2127 sq. ft. of actual interior living space. Also featured is a distinctive entry court, a 90 sq. ft. hobby area extending from the garage, and a wide rear view terrace.

A CENTRAL entry hall has terrazzo tile or slate flooring, depending on the home's exterior styling. Sweeping openness features the main living section, with a 24 ft. x 15 ft. living room, a 14 ft. x 19 ft. x 2 in. family room, and the kitchen contiguous in the rear. A two-way fireplace, with either terrazzo or brick hearth, serves as partial divider between living and family room, with sliding panels to complete the separation when desired. Sliding glass walls lead from both rooms to the terrace. Ash paneling and a semi-cathedral ceiling effect enhance the living room. A convenient pass through opens the kitchen to the family room to complete the area's visual sweep.

THE THREE baths serve different portions of the home. The master bedroom, alone in one wing, has its own dressing room, and adjoining bath. A second bath is convenient to bedrooms two, three and four and the family room, while a third is located off the large service area, behind the kitchen. The home is available in either farmhouse or contemporary styling.

PRICES AT THE new unit start as low as \$25,550 for some models with two bedrooms and den and two baths. The unit adjoins the Palos Verdes Country Club, and is walking distance of the Silver Spur Elementary School. Nine furnished model homes may be reached by way of Crenshaw Blvd. to Silver Spur Rd. and right. Trades are considered, according to direct sales William C. Kulow. Long term 90 per cent financing is available. A few homes may be purchased by veterans on VA terms.

## Ex-Torrance Resident in CHP Course

Former Torrance resident Robert G. Plant has been appointed to the California Highway Patrol and has been assigned to the Patrol's Academy in Sacramento for 12 weeks of training. The new traffic officers will receive instruction in more than 50 subjects related to traffic law enforcement. Emphasis is placed on the California vehicle code, traffic supervision, accident investigation, first-aid, preservation of evidence, court systems and legal procedures, and equipment operation and maintenance. The current class is made up of 80 men from all parts of California. Plant comes to the Patrol directly from the Armed Forces, where he served 14 years in the Army. He also is brother of the Patrol, Traffic Officer David Plant, San Leandro.
