### Summer Recreation Slate Announced for El Camino

Indoor and outdoor recreational activities will be offered to the public at El Camino College for the coming summer in a program which encompasses both the daytime and evening hours. The program will be supervised by college physical education instructors and student recreational leaders. El Camino will offer a swimming instruction program with the registration date set for June 17, at 8 a.m. in the Campus Center. Instruction tickets

for the first three periods will be available at this time. Children must be present when tickets are purchased. **TE FIRST** period will begin June 19 and run to June 29 July 3 to July 14 marks the second period with July 27 to July 28 being the third. Three additional two-week periods of instruction will follow from July 24 to Aug. 26. Cost for a two-week instruction period is \$1. The program will be run on a Monday through Friday basis.

Badminton, volleyball and basketball will be played in league and tournament types of competition and will be featured in the evening program.

### Young Musicians To Appear in Hollywood Bowl

Youngsters from Torrance, Hawthorne and Manhattan Beach will be among 1600 musicians taking part in a massed band concert June 10 in the Hollywood Bowl. The Torrance Area Youth Band, directed by James Van Dyck, will take part in the 18 band event, along with Hawthorne Area Youth Band directed by Fred Morgan and Manhattan Beach Youth Band directed by Robert Stoebel. Event, which brings together youth from all over Southern California, is sponsored by Los Angeles County Music Commission and is said to be among the most unique musical events of its kind in the country.

Throughout Southern California there are more than 40 youth bands sponsored by cities, chambers of commerce, lodges and other organizations which provide musical activities outside of school programs.

BANDS APPEAR in area and state-wide parades and special events, and many have traveled to noted events across the country and Canada.

The program will be conducted by the 18 directors of the participating bands and will feature a wide variety of tempos and styles of music.

Tickets for the event may be obtained from participating bands or at Hollywood Bowl the evening of the program.

Tickets are \$1 each, which is a donation to support the Youth Band Council. Children under 12 will be admitted free.
