Teachers to Distribute Nearly \$10,000 Locally

A total of \$9735 collected by Torrance teachers will be distributed to 40 charities, according to Ernest W. Thom, chairman.

The funds were collected through the Torrance Educational Assn. as part of the group's annual charity drive.

Largest single beneficiary was the Torrance scholarship fund, which was allotted \$1800 to provide a \$600 scholarship to one graduating senior from each of the city's three high schools. The scholarship is given to a student who plans to enter teaching.

The American Field Service will receive \$650, while the Torrance Community Chest will get \$1381; the Torrance YMCA, \$1201; and the Torrance Dental Health Assn., \$1144.

National charities to benefit as follows:

Cancer Society, \$948; Heart Fund, \$633; Mental Health, \$478; Arthritis and Rheumatism, \$284; Multiple Sclerosis, \$232; Muscular Dystrophy, \$213; Cerebral Palsy, \$240; and Red Cross, \$163.

The remainder of the money was designated by teachers to go in small amounts to various other special charities.

Thom pointed out that 80 per cent of the funds collected will go to local charities.

Davidson, the new President, will leave shortly to attend the Lions International Convention at Atlantic City. He is the first president of the local group to represent the club at any International Convention.

The South Torrance Lions have been active in sight conservation work. They recently sponsored a free Glaucoma Clinic and helped to organize the Eye Bank. They also provide aid for needy school children.
