Garden Checklist

1. Prune off faded blooms on Roses, Fuchsias, potted Geraniums before they go to seed.
2. Feed potted tuberous Begonias with liquid fish every two weeks. Once a month is enough for those planted in the ground.
3. If feeding with an acid food fails to green up Camellias and Azaleas, use an iron chelate.
4. Plant cushion Shrysanthemums for a summer-long sow of color.
5. Take hanging baskets down and let them soak under a sprinkler or in a tub of water every now and then to insure complete moisture at the roots.
