**Tips on Caring for Hedgerow in
Dry California Offered Gardeners**

If you can take a hedge or leave it alone, stop reading here. But if you take pride in a clipped row of green and appreciate its contribution to the landscape, read on. There are ways to keep a hedgerow happy which you should know about.

First comes the matter of clipping. According to the California Assn. of Nurserymen, only about one in a hundred gardeners really does the job right.

THE IMPORTANT thing with a formally clipped hedge is to clip it to a pyramidal shape so that the base is wider than the top. This permits the lower reaches of the hedge to absorb the maximum amount of sunlight and stay healthy and dense, rather than thinly foliated and rangy. You can either round the top or shear it flat. It really doesn't make much difference.

If you seek the strictly formal look of traditional gardens, you have to insure that the top is evenly trimmed and level from one end of the hedge to the other. It's a simple matter to do this if you stretch a string tightly between two stakes at the height you want your hedge. Then clip to that height all the way. This is most important with low to medium hedges since slight variations show more.

THE OTHER matters of importance to happy hedges are water and food. Few gardeners seem to realize that most hedges like plenty of water and at least one annual feeding. There is no problem where the hedge is next to lawn or flower bed, but many hedges that border a drive or mark a boundary see no water from one rain to the next. A long canvas soaker stretched out at the roots insures thorough soaking. As for food, use a complete fertilizer in spring or early summer.
