Medallion Homes Construction Pace Shows Increase Over 60

The much-publicized economic recession apparently has had little effect on the mounting demand of Southern Californians for all-electric homes, judging from figures cited by G. L. Blanchard, district manager for Southern California Edison Co.

Contracts for construction of Gold Medallion (all-electric) homes and apartments in Edison's service territory for the first half of 1961 are up 221 per cent over the corresponding figure for last year, Blanchard announced.

AN INCREASE of 35 per cent for the same period was reported in contracts for construction of Bronze Medallion living units — those which, while not "total-electric," meet specified standards of excellence in wiring, lighting and built-in major electrical appliances such as ranges and ovens.

The gains in construction of Gold and Bronze Medallion homes were achieved despite an over-all decline of 12 per cent in the total number of dwelling units completed, as compared with the first six months of 1960, the Edison official pointed out.

CONSTRUCTION of homes with built-in electric heating is running almost double last year's pace, Blanchard added. "The distinctive Medallion insignia, displayed at all Medallion home projects, has given the public an easily recognizable symbol of electrical quality," the Edison official said. "The response, as measured by sales in our service territory, leaves no doubt of the growing popularity of the concept of modern, all-electric living."
