**El Camino Director of Instruction
Set to Attend Four Day Institute**

Dr. William Harless, director of instruction at El Camino college, will attend a four-day institute for college and university administrators on studies of college faculty. The institute will deal with research on problems of motivation, recruitment, and morale of faculty and with studies of teaching load, faculty evaluation, and faculty participation in college and university administration.

The institute will be co-sponsored by the Center for the Study of Higher Education, University of California, Berkeley, and the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education, Boulder, Colorado; it will be held on the Berkeley campus of the University of California July 31 to Aug. 4.

Participants will hear lectures by Dr. Logan Wilson, president, American Council on Education, Washington, D.C.; Dr. John Stecklein, director, Bureau of Institutional Research, University of Minnesota, Minneapolis; Dr. James D. O. Associated Provost, University of Colorado, Boulder; Dr. Kenneth Clark, dean, College of Arts and Sciences, University of Colorado, Boulder; Miss Lucile Allen, consultant, Hogg Foundation for Mental Health, University of Texas, Austin; Dr. Burton Clark, associate research sociologist, Center for the Study of Higher Education and Dr. John Gustad, dean, College of Liberal Arts, Alfred University, New York.
