

County to Open Storm Drain Bids on Friday

Bids for construction of the East Torrance bond issue storm drain, project 587, will be opened by County flood control engineers next Friday morning, according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn's chief deputy, William N. Stivers.

After the bid proposals have been clocked in, opened and read, they will immediately be checked for accuracy and analyzed. If the bids are de-

termined to be satisfactory, recommendation will be made to the Board of Supervisors for award of contract to the low bidder within 30 days.

This will mean that preliminary construction will start by September, if no problems develop.

Allocated \$816,400 in the 1958 bond issue, the storm drain will be built in two lines. The project will be located partly in the second district, represented by Supervisor Hahn, and partly in the Fourth

district, represented by Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

pointed out that the project will eliminate the flooding of the intersection of Crenshaw and 190th St., which has posed a serious problem for many years, as well as provide increased flood control for a large portion of Torrance.

PLANS FOR the project were prepared under the direction of Torrance City Engineer W. M. Nollac.

Contract for the work will be awarded by the Board of Supervisors and the project will be supervised and inspected by engineers of the County Flood Control District.

Construction will require about 11 months after the contract has been awarded.

CLUB TROPICANA: 12 slices sandwich bread, toasted; butter or margarine; 1/4 cup flaked coconut; 1 avocado, sliced; 12 crisp bacon slices; 12 thin slices tomato; lettuce leaves, mayonnaise or salad dressing; 4 slices American cheese (4 oz.); 4 slices pineapple, well drained.

Spread 4 slices toast with butter or margarine. Sprinkle with coconut. Cover coconut with avocado slices and then bacon. Place tomato slices over bacon. Cover tomatoes with lettuce. Top lettuce with 4 more toast slices spread with mayonnaise or salad dressing. Cover with cheese slices. Place pineapple over cheese. Spread remaining toast slices with butter or margarine and close the sandwiches. Secure with wooden picks and trim crusts, if desired. Cut each sandwich diagonally into halves. Garnish with pickles, ripe olives or radish roses. Serve with potato chips. Makes 4 sandwiches.

COTTAGE FRANKS on PUMPERNICKEL: Simmer 1/2 lb. frankfurters. Meanwhile, blend 2 T. softened butter or margarine, 1/2 C. pineapple cottage cheese, 2 t. prepared mustard and 1 T. chopped sweet pickle or relish. Put cooked frankfurters through a food chopper and blend into mixture. Serve on thick slices of pumpernickel.
