Dr. Tirso Del Junco, Cuban-born schoolmate of dictator Fidel Castro, will speak tonight at an 8 p.m. meeting of the South Bay Chapter, Californians for Goldwater. His topic for the meeting, to be held at the Smith Bros. Fish Shanty, 4020 Pacific Coast Hwy., will be "Castro, Russian Agent for 17 Years," and "Will Cuba Start World War III?"

A resident of the United States since 1949, Del Junco now lives with his wife and four children in Pasadena. He is president of Sociedad Ayuda

Cubana Anti-Communist, author of several medical journals, and a member of the Los Angeles County Medical Assn. The 35-year old doctor is a member of the staff at Queen of Angels, St. Vincent's and St. Joseph's hospitals in Los Angeles.

Del Junco was a member of the Cuban Army of Liberation which landed on April 17, 1961, and will be appearing at the Sports Arena Aug. 30 at the Southern California Anti-Communist School.
