Methodist Youth at Conference

Karen Henderson of Torrance will be part of a 105-member delegation from Southern California and Arizona who will attend the seventh national Methodist Student Conference. The conference will be held at the University of Illinois in Champaign, Urbana.

Held every four years the conference is devoted to lectures, sermons, Bible study, discussion and recreation. This year, in addition, the students will explore such special topics as morality on the campus, problems of a class church, national purpose, Africa, and nonconformity and cultural rebellion.

Bishop Gerald Kennedy, of Los Angeles, will be the morning preacher this Sunday, as he returns from Oslo, Norway, and the World Methodist Conference.

Another Southern Californian, Dr. J. Wesley Robb, is author of one of two study books for the student conference, "An Inquiry Into Faith." Dr. Robb is associate professor and chairman of the undergraduate department of religion at the University of Southern California.

About 3000 college students are expected for the conference, which will continue through Thursday, Aug. 31.

Most of the Southern California-Arizona students are traveling in three chartered buses.

New Building Started By Plastics Firm

Construction is now under way on a new two-story building at 2424 Moreton St. for Space Equipment Corp. which has purchased the plastics division of Horkey-Moore Associates.

The plastics division was purchased from Houston-Fearless Corp. Terms of the purchase were not announced.

Renamed Kerr Products, the first 13,000 square foot unit will house the company offices, engineering department and research laboratories. Completion is scheduled by Oct. 1.
