Adventurer John Goddard Opens LAHC Forum Tonight

John Goddard, world-famous adventurer and explorer will open the Harbor College Forum series at 8 tonight in the main gym on the Wilmington campus.

Goddard, who has appeared to capacity audiences in two previous appearances on the Forum series, will narrate in person his full length color film, "Exploring Lands Down Under." The film will feature fascinating highlights of New Zealand, Australia, and New Guinea.

AUSTRALIA is characterized by Goddard as being one of the oldest and sunniest of the seven continents, with one of

the youngest and lushest of the world's civilizations. The bustling life of Sydney, the largest city, will be contrasted with the Outback, the bleak interior with the world's largest cattle ranches.

Appearing in the film will be some of the world's most unusual animals, the kangaroo, platypus, wombat, kookaburra, and dingo. Marine life will also be shown when Goddard investigates the undersea fairylands of the Great Barrier Reef.

The world's most primitive people, the Australian Aborigines, will be shown staging their colorful "Corroboree" dance as well as exhibiting their skill with the boomerang.

This research resulted in her writing "Many Mansions" and "The World Within," both best sellers.

Dr. Cerminara is a well-known lecturer and an eminently qualified teacher of semantics. Her topic for Friday night will be "Some Practical Uses for E.S.P."
