

# Prevention of Home Fires Simple With Precautions

Getting "fired up" now to correct careless housekeeping habits will keep your home from burning up later.

Speaking in support of National Fire Prevention Week today through Friday, C. J. Weiss, Allstate Safety Crusade regional representative, placed the main responsibility of preventing home fires squarely upon adults.

"A casual attitude by men and women toward smoking is a much greater fire danger than the popular notion of children playing with matches," he said.

OVERLOADING ashtrays or emptying them into waste-

paper baskets is an open invitation to trouble," he warns. "The statistics show that lighting lighted smoking materials around haphazardly, together with smoking in bed, accounts for one out of every four home fires."

Weiss urges every homeowner to brush up on the facts of fires. They can be prevented most of the time by being conscientious about discarding cigarettes, cigars and pipe ashes, storing flammable materials and removing rubbish from the house.

"WITH THE increasing number of households, home fires

pose an ever growing threat," Weiss points out. "Right now, more than half of all deaths from fire each year occur when houses go up in smoke."

To guard against the common type of home fires, the crusade suggests the following housekeeping precautions:

1. See that rubbish does not accumulate (particularly in the attic, basement, garage, closets and outside near the house) and have it picked up regularly.
2. Put tobacco ashes, cigarette and cigar butts, and used matches in ashtrays of adequate size and shape to hold them.

3. Empty ashtrays into a covered metal container after their contents have stopped smoking.

4. Never place a loaded ashtray on a bed or on stuffed furniture and refrain from smoking if you feel drowsy.

5. Keep lighters, matches and lighted "smokes" where children and pets can't reach them.

6. Before retiring for the night, check all rooms to make sure no one has left a cigarette, cigar or pipe burning anywhere, especially after a party.

7. Periodically check all electric cords, particularly for

appliances, and replace those which are frayed.

8. Make sure oily mops are hung up and oily rags are kept in a tightly closed can or preferably are thrown away after use.

9. Never use flammable liquids like gasoline for cleaning clothes, or kerosene for starting fires.

10. Store flammable liquids in closed, unbreakable containers to minimize chances of dangerous fumes escaping.

11. Do not store cooking fats, grease, or other flammable items on or near the kitchen stove.

12. Regularly clean the oven and broiler in the kitchen stove, and the exhaust fan and duct.
