

# Supervisors Ask Study On Sewage Water Use

An economic feasibility study on the possible salvaging and reclaiming at least 300,000,000 gallons of waste sewage water which is dumped into the ocean each day was ordered by the County Board of Supervisors.

The move is one of the first steps toward an immediate solution to Southern California's growing water shortage, according to supervisors.

Cooperating in the study with the chief administrative officer are the chief engineers of the County Flood Control District, county sanitation dis-

tricts and Los Angeles city officials.

**SUPERVISOR** Kenneth Hahn stated that about 600,000,000 gallons of sewage water is wasted into the ocean each day from the Hyperion plant and from White's Point, with 300,000,000 gallons of the water going through each plant.

"It would cost about \$60,000,000 to provide treatment plants to purify 300,000,000 gallons of water each day to be pumped back into the underground basins to replenish our water supplies and also to prevent the intrusion of salt

water," the supervisor declared.

The entire program would be self-supporting as water experts have stated that there is a ready market for the purified, salvaged water.

"Now is the time for action. Within five years the plants could be in operation 365 days a year, saving 300,000,000 gallons of precious water each day," Supervisor Hahn declared.

**HAHN** pointed out the irony of the fact that while no federal funds are available for the reclamation of waste sewage

for the benefit of Southern California, the federal government has under consideration a proposal to pay one half of the \$168 million cost of constructing a dam on the Volta river in Ghana in the north-eastern part of Africa.

"The Ghana river area, which this dam would serve, covers 8,000 square miles and has a population of 500,000—less than half the number of residents of each of the Los Angeles County Supervisorial Districts," he stated.

Hahn stated that the scientific and engineering feasibility of water salvaging on a

large scale had already been proved out.

**THERE IS A** reclamation plant at Pomona which is salvaging 4,000,000 gallons of sewage each day.

The county sanitation districts are constructing a plant at Whittier Narrows at a cost of \$1,300,000 which will salvage 10,000,000 gallons a day when it is placed in operation next summer.

"We know that it can be done, so we must move forward with saving and conserving our water supplies. It is a crime to waste this valuable water," Hahn declared.

Within five years the program to save 300,000,000 can be in operation. On the other hand, it will be at least until
