Fourteen thousand Scouts saw two stage shows at 9:15 a.m. and 1 p.m., starring television, recording, and vaude-

ville personalities. Arnold C. Sorenson, Scout executive of the Los Angeles Area Council, Boy Scouts of America, and John Preis, manager of the South Bay May Co., welcomed the crowd. Seven Scout councils in Los Angeles County participated. Headlining the show were Mark Wilson, star of the


