

Law in Action

Workman's compensation covers "industrial injuries" clearly caused by one's work in the form of hospital, medical, disability, lump sum, and death benefits for the worker or his family.

It may also cover some diseases not often thought of as industrial injuries, when they arise out of one's work. It is not enough for the disease to arise during work; one's work must have caused the special exposure which brought on the injury.

or dusty places sometimes get lung diseases. Working in ice-boxes, flues, caves, or in cold areas may present special health hazards. Lifting weights can cause hernia. Bending over a drawing board may cause back injuries.

Sometimes injuries come from "continuous stress and strain" and are not strictly "occupational diseases."

ONE 56-YEAR-OLD derrick operator who often had to work 10 to 19 hours a day, five or six days a week, had a heart attack. Since he smoked

little and drank less, the court found that his work had caused his heart attack. He could draw workman's compensation benefits.

Another worker had to walk over hard ground at high altitudes to which he was unaccustomed. His work was held to have caused his heart attack.

AGAIN A manager of a waterfront business, who often had to deal with toughs, had a heart attack. The strain of his job caused the attack.

Special laws apply to peace officers and firemen, permitting special coverage because of their unusual dangers.

Telephone Company Warns 'Christmas Crush' Is Here

"The Christmas Crush" once again is close at hand. Best known by operators everywhere as that period around Dec. 25 each year when millions of people decide simultaneously to call loved ones

and friends at some distant point, this year's "Crush" is expected to be the heaviest in history, according to Bernard LeBaron, Palos Verdes division manager for General Telephone Co.

"Last year our operators located throughout Southern California handled a record number of calls to various parts of the United States and to foreign countries. Nearly 100,000 long distance messages were completed from 6 p.m. Christmas Eve until midnight Christmas night," he said, adding that the same 30-hour period this year is expected to become even more congested.

For people planning local or cross country holiday telephone calls, the division manager offered some helpful suggestions:

Plan your holiday "get-togethers" by phone for some period other than for Dec. 24 or 25. The same rates apply after 6 p.m. daily and every Sunday.

CALL BY number and get the area code well in advance of the holiday period. Operators are available before the

heavy traffic period to provide telephone numbers in distant cities.

If you have Direct Dialing, be sure to use this service, the fastest means of communication between any points. More DDD lines are available after 11 p.m.

Because of the number of people making calls you may not reach your party on the first try. If this occurs the operator will be happy to furnish the call routing. Making a note of this routing for further reference will help speed up subsequent attempts.

"Above all," he urged, you have trouble reaching the operator during peak hours be patient, for the operator is an extremely popular person — the most talked-to individual in any community during the holidays."


