Camino Theater Classes Present 'Mr. Roberts'

El Camino College theater arts students will present the annual midwinter play, "Mister Roberts," Jan. 12, 13, 19 and 20, in the college Campus Theater.

Directed by Burnett Ferguson, the play is centered upon the activities of a group of men thrown together far from the zone of action during combat.

"Mister Roberts" portrays the discontent and boredom of a group of men in the back area of the Pacific who take out their anger on the captain.

ORIGINALLY a comedy, based on the book by Thomas Heggen, the laughter of the play is always about to dissolve in the pathos of lonely men caught in a world too vast and complex for them to understand.

The main character of the production, "Mister Roberts," is portrayed by Cliff Potts, theater arts major, who has appeared in several other campus dramas and musicals.

FOR ROBERTS the war is an uninterrupted struggle with the captain to obtain a transfer from the cargo ship to a fighting ship.

The Captain finds the war a chance of a lifetime to advance in rank even if it means the sacrifice of the crew. The captain is played by Leo McLaughlin of Torrance.

PLAYED BY Dennis Morgan, Inglewood, Ensign Pulver sees the war as a personal adventure which has lost its glamour.

As the favorite officer of Mr. Roberts, John Leifhelm, Inglewood, plays Doc. Doc manages to detach himself from the issue of war and has an ironic acceptance of things as he sees them.

Student producer of the mid-winter play is Miss Carolyn Waddingham of Torrance.

Sets are under the direction of Les Thomas and costumes will be handled by Miss Julie O'Neil of Hawthorne and Miss Ila Archibald of Torrance.

PROPS FOR THE production will be directed by Miss Shiley Turk, Manhattan Beach, Miss Sally Slater of Torrance and Miss Gail Wilkins of Manhattan Beach.

Tickets for the January play will go on sale in the campus Student Store after Christmas vacation.

Civil Service Exams Set For Positions With City

The City of Torrance announced examination dates for five positions with various city departments this week. Positions open include a senior engineering aide, engineering police matron and file clerk, junior civil engineer, and a park maintenance man.

Jan. 3 is the last date to file for the police matron and file clerk position. The examination will be given Jan. 13. The applicant must be between the ages of 21 and 31, at least 5 ft. 4 inches, and 115 pounds. Maximum height and weight are 6 ft. 1 inch and 173 pounds. Education must include the equivalent of the twelfth grade level and the applicant must have a valid operator's license.

AN EXAMINATION for the park maintenance man will be given Jan. 20, and the final date for filing is Jan. 10. The position requires routine and semi-skilled work in the care of landscaped and garden areas. The applicants must have at least six months experience in garden, nursery, or ranching work, or in a park

maintenance department. The applicant must be a resident of the city.

Examinations for the junior civil engineer and two engineering aides will be given Jan. 27. Final date for filing is Jan. 17. All three positions require experience. The junior civil engineer position requires four years of experience in engineering work or related fields, but college work may be substituted on a year-for-year basis.

TWO YEARS experience in surveying or drafting is required for the senior engineering aide position, and college work may be substituted on a year-for-year basis. The engineering aide position requires a minimum of one year experience in drafting or field survey work.

Written examinations and oral interviews are required for all applicants for all positions.
