## General Telephone Makes Safety Records Available

In the interest of student safety, General Telephone Co. is now offering, free of charge, to public, private, and parochial elementary schools within the 160 communities the company serves, a 78 rpm record of safety songs, "The Traffic Light Song" and "I Like to Ride My Bike," featuring Annie Oakley and the Sandpipers with Mitch Miller and his orchestra, according to Bernard LeBaron, Palos Verdes division manager.

"These melodies, each emphasizing a phase of safety training, are pleasant to the ear and will be helpful in elementary safety," he said.

A presentation of General's first record was made last week in Los Angeles to C. C. Trillingham, superintendent of schools for Los Angeles County, by Jean Howell, audio visual coordinator for General Telephone Co.

General's film library, consisting of more than 1,000 films, with multiple prints of most of the titles, includes many topics other than telephone subjects appealing to all age groups.
