

# Health Officer Reviews Polio Shot Requirement

Written evidence that a student has been immunized against poliomyelitis prior to being admitted to school will be required of all students who change schools or enroll as new students on or after Jan. 15, announced Dr. E. W. Kendrick, district health officer, Los Angeles County Health Department.

A new law, State Assembly Bill No. 1940, will affect new students enrolling in private or public elementary schools, secondary schools, kindergartens, junior colleges, and adult education classes.

AT THIS TIME the law does not affect pupils who entered

school during the first semester of the 1961-62 school year and remain in the same school. In September, the law will be applicable to all students when they apply for school admission.

According to the new law, three inoculations against polio are needed. At least one polio injection will be necessary for entry to school with completion of the total of three injections required in one year. The time interval between each consecutive shot must be more than two weeks apart.

FOR PERSONS immunized before Jan. 1, 1962, a written statement by a parent or guardian giving the approximate dates of immunization is required for the school authorities. For those immunized after Jan. 1, 1962, a written record stating the name of the person immunized, his birth date, the date of each inoculation, the kind of vaccine used, and the name of the physician or agency giving the inoculation is required.

Parents who do not believe in immunization must file a

written statement of their belief.

POLIOMYELITIS vaccination can be secured from private physicians, the Los Angeles County Medical Assn., and National Foundation Dollar Clinics (call the associations for their clinic schedules.)

The Los Angeles County Health Department will offer vaccinations at all their major health centers and many of their sub-centers. Shots will be offered at the Torrance Health Center, 2300 W. Carson St., Torrance, from 8 to 9 a.m. and

3 to 4 p.m., Mondays through Fridays. The clinics are limited to student-residents of Los Angeles County who need the immunization for school admission.

SINCE THE law provides for a charge to be collected from the person immunized to cover the cost, the fee will be \$1 per injection.

No charge will be made of pupils who are clients of county or state aid or who present written notice from school personnel that free service is indicated.

## New Interest Rate Adopted By American
