

South High's Senior Class Offers Drama

Alberto Casella's drama, "Death Takes a Holiday," will be presented by the senior class of South High on Friday and Saturday in the South High cafeteria, 4801 Pacific Coast Hwy.

The play, rewritten for the American stage by Walter Ferris, is set in the castle of the Duke Lambert de Catalica (played by Lee Larsen) in southern Italy. It concerns an experiment in which Death (portrayed by Rocky Manning) exchanges his usual form for that of a human being to find out why mortals fear him.

During this time he tries to discover the meanings of such human traits as kindness, pity, fear, and love. But in becoming human he is caught in a desire to share with someone his freshly-found truths. His search for that person is not an easy one.

THE CHARACTERS from whom Death learns what humans value include the Princess San Luca, played by Betsy Chappelle; her daughter, Grazia, played by Rosemary McIlraith and Sandy Maxwell; the Baron Ceasarea, played by

Richard Vogl; his daughter-in-law, Aida, played by Madelein Dupuis. Others in the cast are Bobbet King, Doug Forster, Shelley Lessin, Kathy Turner, Bill Latham, Mike Grove, and Steve Bailey.

The play is directed by Marlin Muse and technical production is under the supervision of Von Hershey. The production will mark the first use of a series of lights recently purchased by the student council and the South High chapter of the National Thespian Society.

Tickets may be purchased at the cafeteria box office for \$1. Curtain time is 8.
